


Cattle egrets are tall, thin, white birds that hang out around cows or horses in the pasture.







Finally, the turtle trudged along. Slow, but steady. Step by step. He just focused and kept going.


And guess what? The turtle won the race!

#### GOD 15 WITH YOU

The LORD hasn't lost his powerful strength; he can still hear and answer prayers.

Isaiah 59:1

Antonio's Dad was going far away . . . again. They wouldn't even be able to FaceTime him very much this time. Even though they tried to say it was fine, he could tell his parents were nervous. He would find his mom crying sometimes.

Antonio's mind kept dreaming up all kinds of bad things that could happen to his dad, and to his family while his dad was gone. Nightmares kept waking him up at night.

What could you tell Antonio to help him during the times when he is afraid?

You could remind him that, because God is everywhere, he will be with him and with his dad at the exact same time. Tell him God hears every prayer we pray. Tell him next time he has a nightmare to say, "God is still strong! He hears my prayers!" God hasn't become old or tired or too far away to hear you. He is very close!

Instead of nightmares, pray God replaces those scary thoughts with with thoughts of God's powerful strength, like this week's verse talks about. God will help Antonio's dad . . . and Antonio . . . and you!

Dear God, I know you hear my prayers. Please protect me and my family today.





#### Doing Good

I am the vine, and you are the branches. If you stay joined to me, and I stay joined to you, then you will produce lots of fruit. But you cannot do anything without me.


Wow! It's a miracle just to breathe.



Praise God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! The Father is a merciful God, who always gives us comfort. He comforts us when we are in trouble, so that we can share that same comfort with others in trouble.

2 Corinthians 1:3-4

Do you know Jesus sees you when you cry?

Do you know he is sad with you?

But even best friends, siblings, and parents don't always understand you. Sometimes you don't even understand you.



Day and night they never stopped singing, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord, the all-powerful God, who was and is and is coming!"

Never been selfish? But *everyone* has been selfish at some point, at least in how they think! Knowing this, you turn away from the guard, sadly.





Would he care if you needed him? Of course! He cares even more than your parents! And that's a lot!



We need to fight against the part of ourselves that wants to do bad things. But we can't do it on our own. God helps us fight! He is so powerful!







It is hard to be good sometimes! It can wear a kid out. God wants us to be good, too. And the great thing is, he promises to help us do it!


