Isaiah 51:12




And then you will face all your new adventures with the help that comes from God. Don't fear!

God will always forgive you and move your sin far, far away. And he can help you forgive others, too. God will show you how!




God, I'm sorry when I do things that are wrong. I love you and I want to be close to you always!

How can you do that? God loves you so much that he gives you a way to be with him forever. You can start by reading your Bible (God's Word!) and saying a simple prayer to God . . .




God, thank you for changing my heart! I want to be like you.




God wants you to be part of the great work he is doing here on Earth. He will help you learn and grow so you can do his work. He can even help you learn how to spell Zerubbabel!

And the cool part is, he can use you to help change other people's lives, too.


You know Jesus, so you can help other people know him by telling them about him.

Jesus loves you so much, so you can love other people by being kind.


This week's Bible verse reminds you that Jesus asks you to do good things with his help. So what will you do for Jesus?

God loves you and wants to talk to you every, single day.


He wants to teach you things and help you. You can ask him any questions that you have. You don't need a phone or a special meeting. Just talk!




