


God created all humans, but, sadly, we chose to do wrong things, sometimes called sins.





Will you pray for your country today?




All these wonderful things remind us of how much God loves us. And best of all, God sent his Son Jesus to be with us and save us from our sins. That makes even the worst days better than just okay.





The tallest tree in the world is a Redwood in California named Hyperion.



We can find out what lives in the deepest oceans or how hot Mars is or how to get people to quit sneezing.


JOWING








The Grand Canyon in Arizona is one mile deep.

You may never know all the ways God keeps you safe, but you can thank him for all of it!


God, thank you for keeping me safe. You are my rock! You are my fort! Nothing is too tough for you.






Adult meerkats teach their babies how to hunt and handle dangerous prey, like scorpions.






