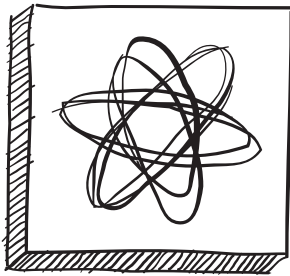
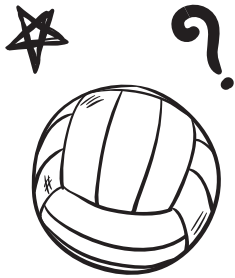

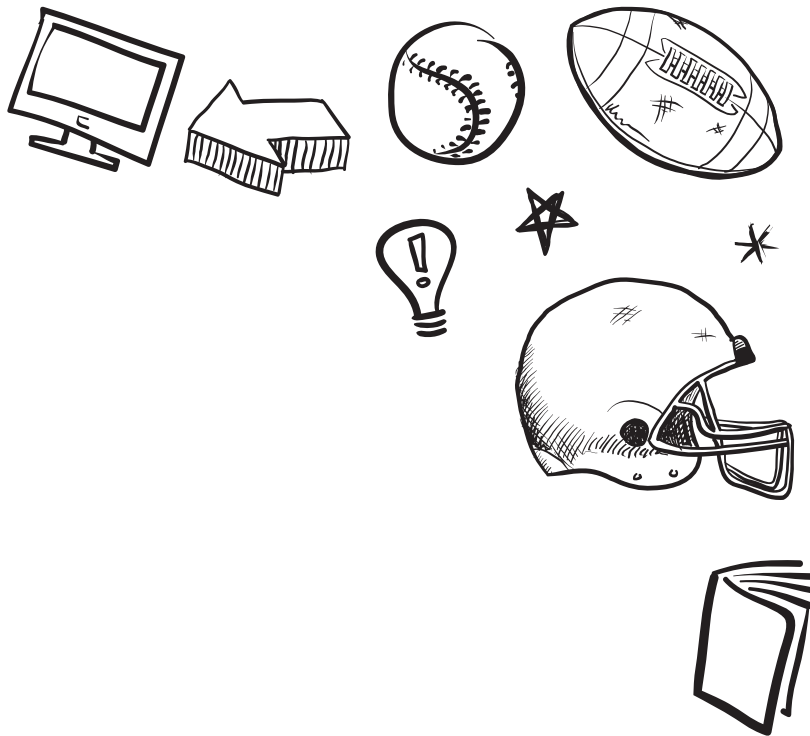

You don't have to just imagine these things. You can help make them happen by loving Jesus and telling others about him!

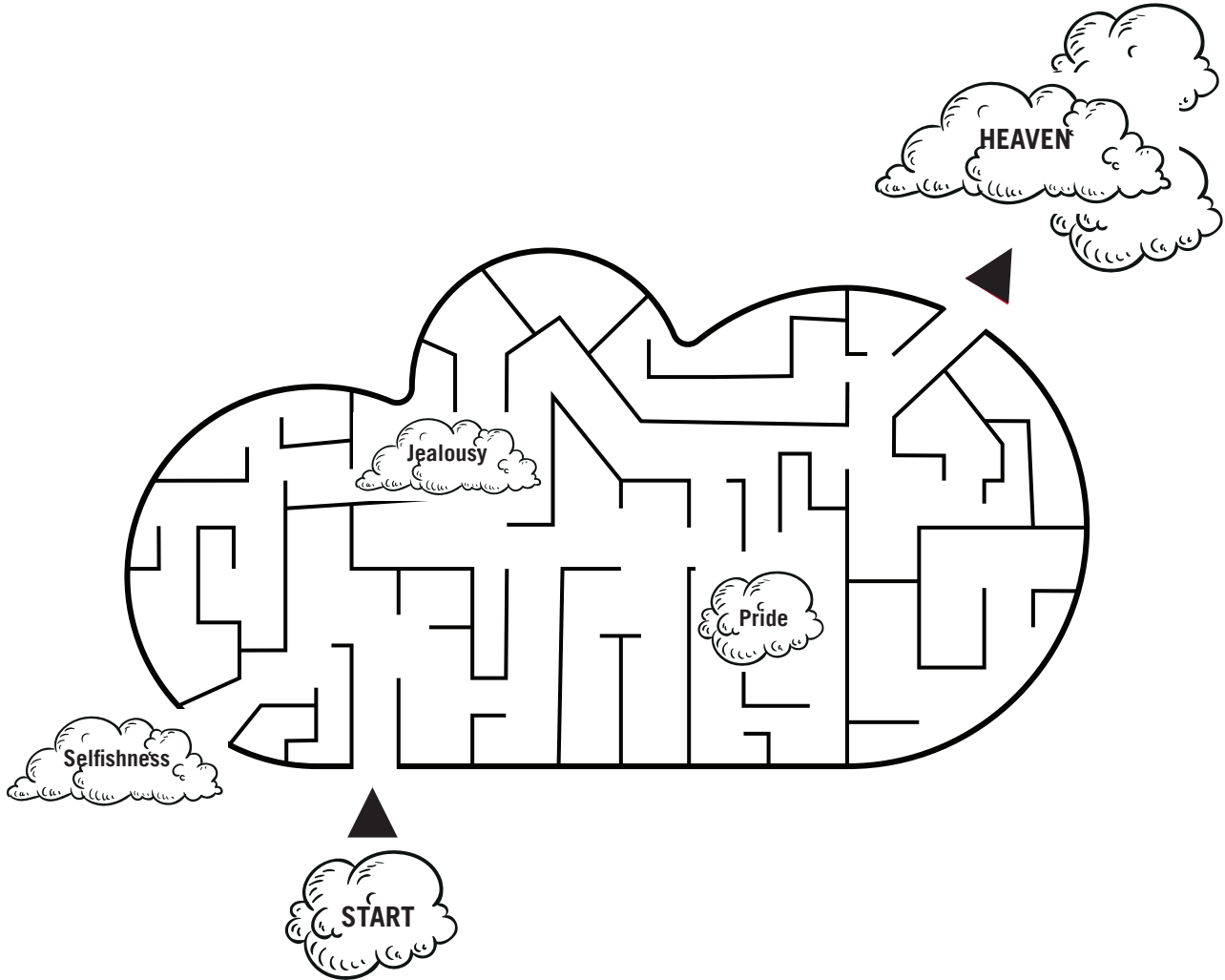
It's good to think about the end of the story and the things Jesus promises us. It helps us to wait and to pray for people to turn to God.
