Step 1: As a family, read the Scripture (back) and refelction (below).

Step 2: Discuss the Scripture using the Family Discussion Questions (right) to learn how to apply it to your lives.

Step 3: Take the Memory Verse Challenge this season and complete the *Acknowledge and Anticipate* family activity (back) to praise the Lord for what he did in 2023 and excitedly wait for what he has in store for 2024!

Imagine being at a change of command ceremony. The event formally symbolizes a transfer of responsibility to a new commander. The outgoing commander will most likely be recognized and honored for his accomplishments. Then there will be a time to look ahead and anticipate what the new commander will dive into. The ceremony includes a symbolic passing of the unit flag.

Now imagine if it were typical in these ceremonies to highlight the old commander's failures and to outline the ways the new commander is doomed from the start! That would be hard to watch, and no one would want to attend.

Yet sometimes that's just how we approach the Lord.

Often, we focus only on our disappointments and unmet desires, like the friends we are leaving behind or the new school we have yet to fit into. And as we look ahead, we might expect that nothing will change for the better. But God is faithful to "take care of all your needs with the wonderful blessings that come from Christ Jesus!" (Philippians 4:19).

As we enter the new year, we have the opportunity to treat it much like a change of command ceremony. As the year closes, take time to honor the Lord for all the good in your life. Think through the specific ways that he grew your faith and made you a better Christ-follower. And dream about what he might want to do in and through you this year. He loves a gracious and hopeful heart!
