Imagine being outside playing tag late on a summer night. The moon and fireflies can only help you see so far, so it's nearly impossible to tag your friends. You use a strong flashlight, not only to guide your steps, but to find your friends and win the game.

Psalm 119 tells us that God's Word is like the strongest flashlight. It helps you walk forward with confidence and also stay on the right path and win the prize.

How could words on paper have so much light? Psalm 119 is the longest chapter in the whole Bible. It is written as a poem that celebrates God's Word and God's teachings. There are 22 stanzas in this poem, and the lines in each section start with a different letter of the Hebrew alphabet. Verses 105–112 all start with the letter "Nun." Our poet seems to be surrounded by darkness and danger. He can't see his next step without God's Word. But God's love letter to us has power over darkness, and it can be our source of joy and most prized posession, too (verse 111).

Read the rest of Psalm 119 as a family this week, one stanza at a time. And let his love letter light up your life.
