The man got right up. He picked up his mat and went out while everyone watched in amazement. They praised God and said, "We have never seen anything like this!"

Mark 2:12

So a man walks into a house—

No, wait. He was paralyzed.

So a paralyzed man was carried into a house—

Well, not exactly.

Actually, what happened was Jesus was in a house and the place was packed with people. No room to move. Worse than a family reunion with your cousins. No one could get in, especially not four men carrying a paralyzed guy on a mat.

But these friends were determined. They had heard about Jesus healing all kinds of people from all kinds of things. They loved their friend and they believed Jesus could heal him. So they looked at the problem and came up with a new plan: they got their friend up to the roof (not easy). They made a hole in the roof (probably didn't make the homeowner happy). 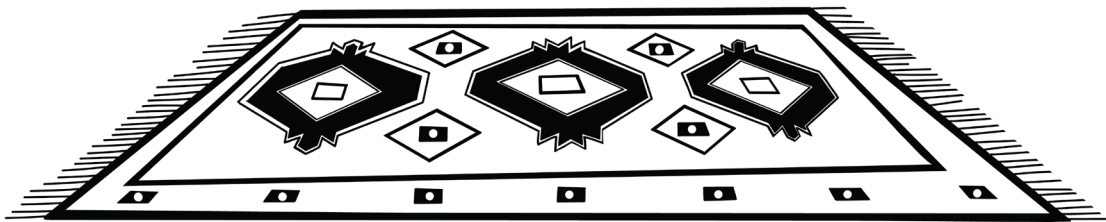

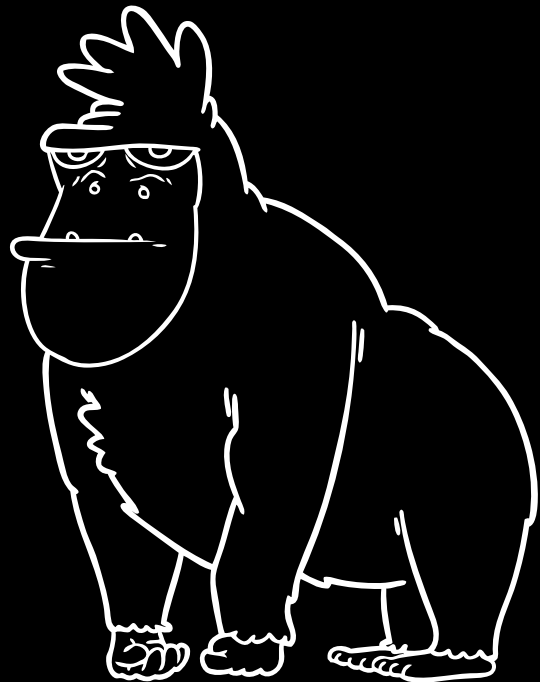

Is God All Love and Rainbows?



When God had finished speaking to Moses on Mount Sinai, he gave him the two flat stones on which he had written all his laws with his own hand.

Exodus 31:18

If God were going to meet with you, what would you expect?

Moses told the Israelites to wash up and put on clean clothes. They were expecting company—God himself. They were camped at the base of Mount Sinai. On the morning of the appointment, they woke up to a very loud trumpet blast. God came down onto the mountain. Thunder and lightning erupted in the sky. Fire and smoke covered the top of the mountain. The whole mountain shook. Not exactly a welcome mat!

But Moses and the leaders went up and saw God. They later said that God was standing on something like a pavement of jewels, like the blue sky. And they ate there in God's presence.

Then Moses went further up the mountain and God told him what he wanted from his people. He gave ten clear commands. Using his finger, God wrote them on two stones Moses could take back with him.

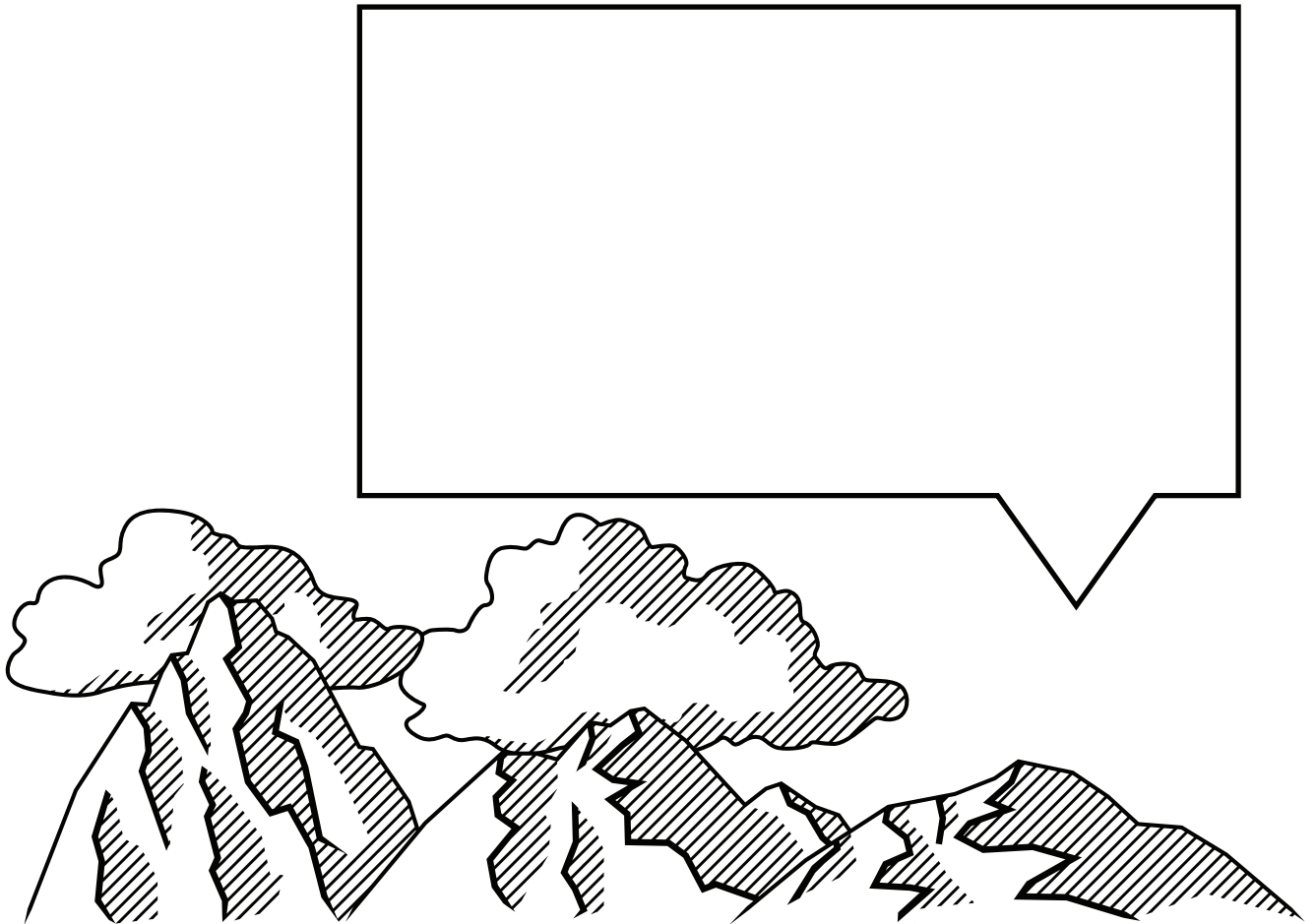
Like military orders, the message was clear: These laws were to be followed. The lightning and fire and smoke and noise emphasized God's awesome power. The Israelites were terrified, but agreed. They knew that the God who loved and saved them also expected obedience and would punish those who refused to obey. So, God is definitely love and sometimes rainbows, but he also requires our obedience.

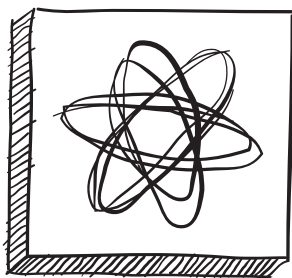
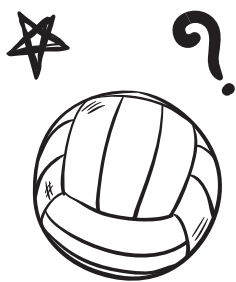

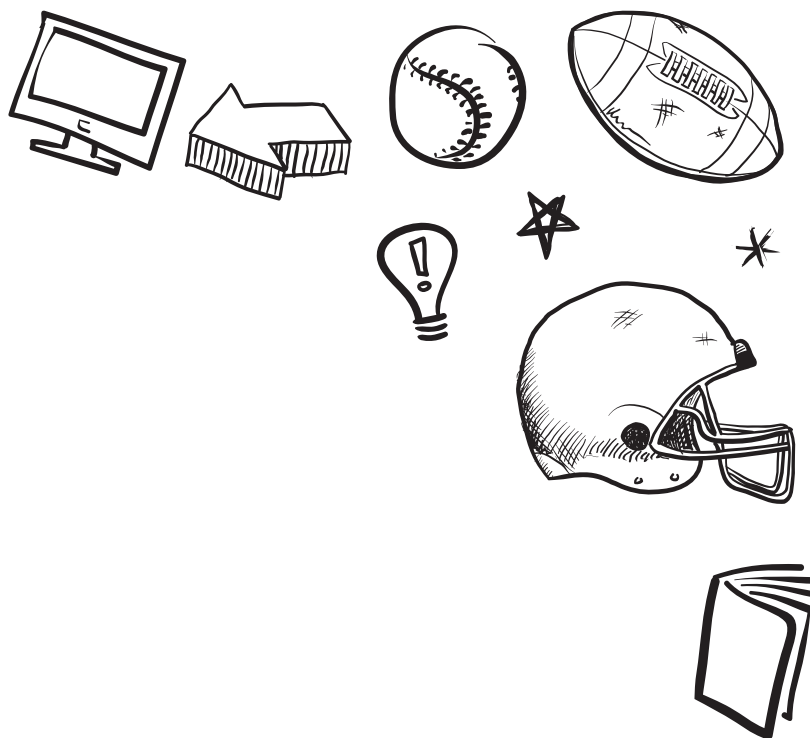

How Do We Know Jesus is God?



*The boy sat up and began to speak. Jesus
then gave him back to his mother.*

Luke 7:15

The spark of life—the power that jumpstarts our hearts—the whisper that tells our lungs to breathe—we don't understand it, but we can know where it comes from because of several Bible stories, including this one in Luke:

Jesus was walking with a large crowd. At the edge of a small town, they met a group of people coming the other way with a dead body. It was a funeral for a young man, his mother's only child, headed out to bury him. This left his mother alone, since her husband had also died. She was walking with them, crying.

Instead of side-stepping this sad scene, Jesus went right to the mother. He hates sorrow and death and hopelessness. He is the God of life and love and care. When she had no hope, he interrupted her grief. "Don't cry," he said.

Then he touched the stretcher with the body on it so the people carrying it would stop. Most people would be afraid of getting contaminated by a dead body, but that did not worry Jesus. Then he told the young man to get up. And he did. The spark of life was back! His heart was beating again, his lungs breathing, his muscles moving. He sat up and talked. And everyone who saw it started saying, "God is with us!"

In the end, we know Jesus is God because He has the power to give life, heal the brokenhearted, and bring hope where there seems to be none.

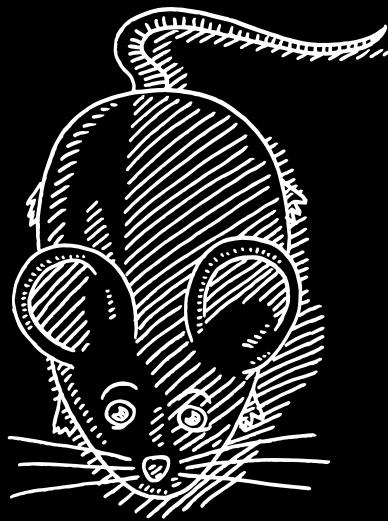

The angel said, "You had no right to treat your donkey like that! I was the one who blocked your way, because I don't think you should go to Moab."

Numbers 22:32

Sometimes, even a donkey can see we are going the wrong way.

When the king of Moab saw God's people conquer a neighboring country, he was terrified his land was next. He sent messengers with money to a famous prophet, asking for some solid curses to be called down on Israel.

Balaam spoke with God about the request and was told no. Still, Balaam wanted the money, so he kept toying with the idea and the messengers. He decided to go with them, even though he told them he couldn't curse Israel.

As Balaam is riding his donkey on the road to the king's house, the animal suddenly takes off into a field. He beats the donkey, and they start again.

Finally, the donkey just lies down. Again the donkey gets beaten. But this time the animal says, "What did I do? Why are you beating me?" Suddenly Balaam can see an angel, with a sword, keeping him from going where God said not to.

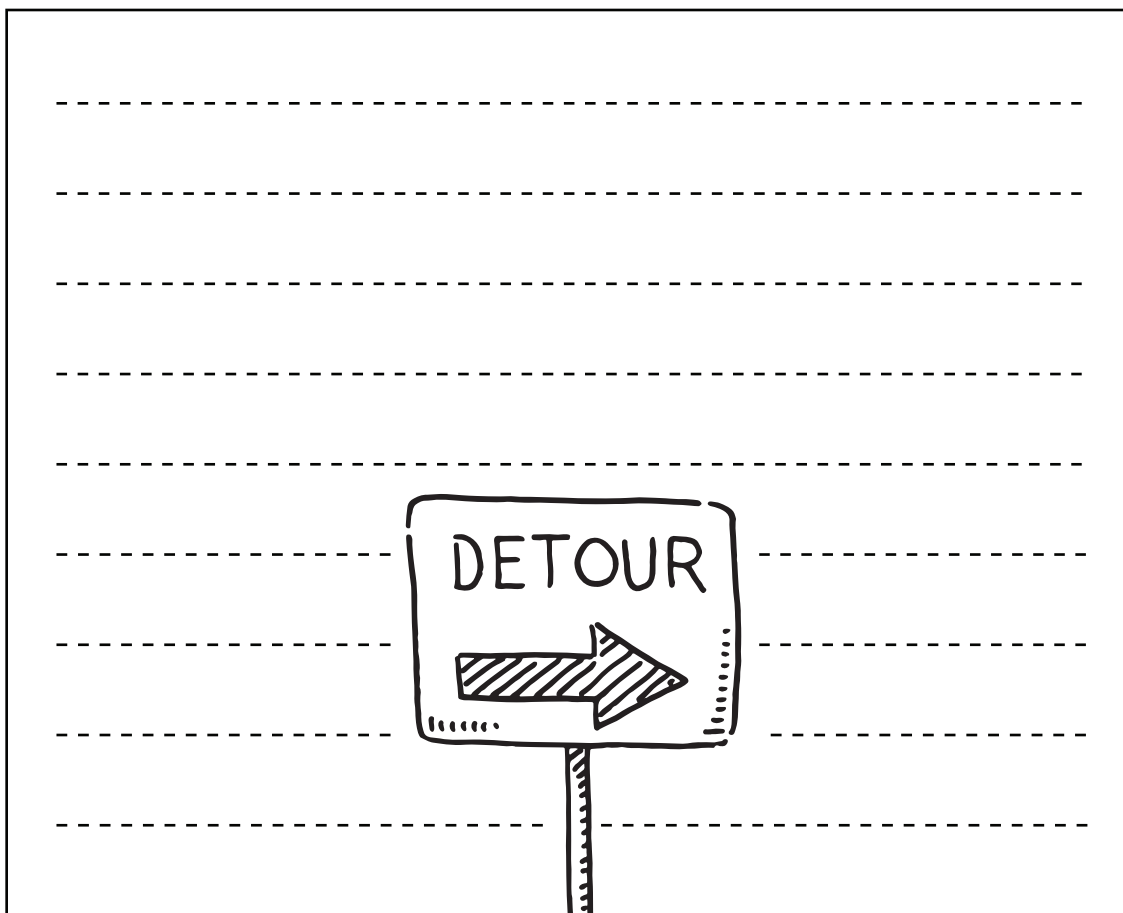
It took a talking donkey to keep Balaam out of trouble. God cares about the choices we make and wants to guide us on the right path, no matter what he has to use.

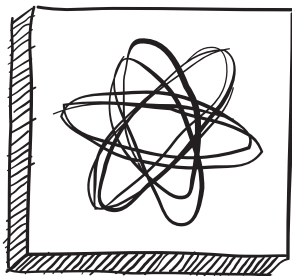
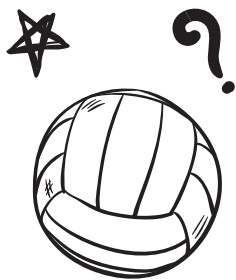

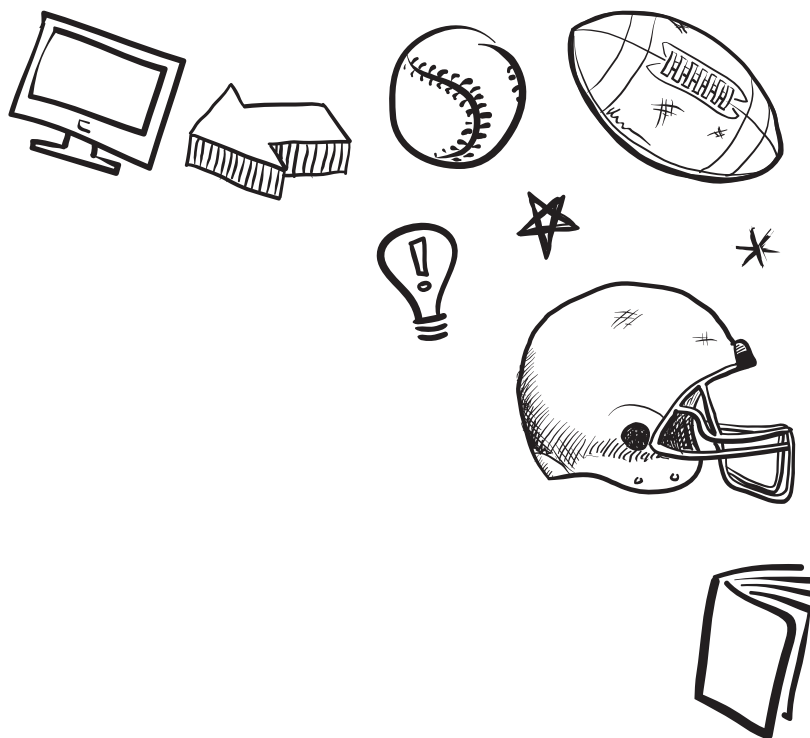

Does Jesus Want Me Just to Follow a Bunch of Rules?



Then Jesus told the man, "Hold out your hand." The man did, and it became as healthy as the other one.

Matthew 12:13

It was a showdown! In one corner, Jesus. In the other, the Pharisees—experts in Jewish law who liked being in charge. Caught in the middle, a man with a useless hand, shriveled up like a bird's foot.

They were in the Pharisees' synagogue on the Sabbath day, the day God set aside for rest. The Pharisees were known for adding lots of extra rules to make absolutely sure people would not disobey God's law. They knew Jesus could heal people and they wanted to get Jesus into trouble. "You can't do work on the Sabbath," they growled, "not even to help someone."

"Even you would save one of your sheep on this day," Jesus shot back. "And people are worth far more than sheep. So it is right to do good on the Sabbath." Jesus knew the Pharisees were missing the point. They stared at each other. Then Jesus made his move. "Stretch out your hand," he told the man.

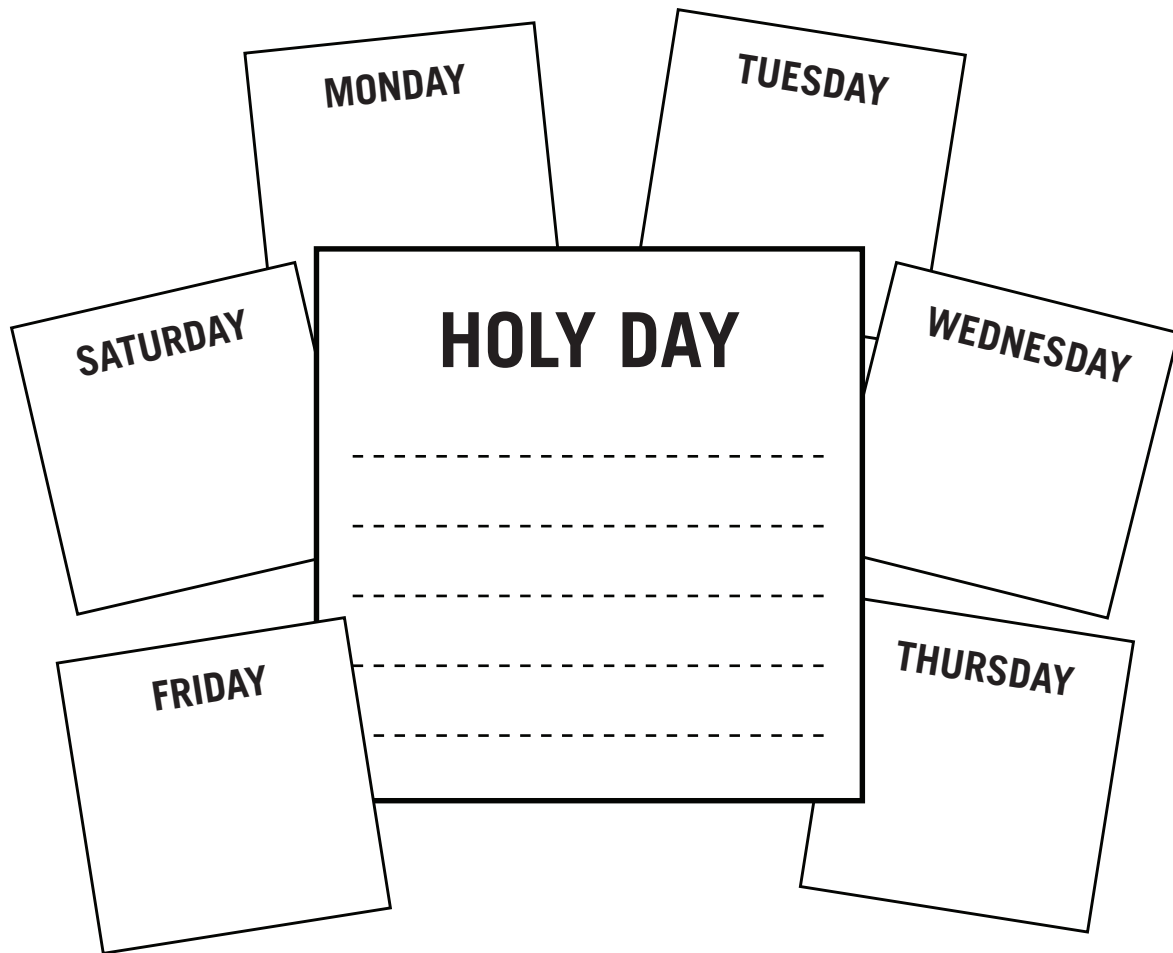

But the Pharisees stalked out and started plotting how they could kill Jesus. Following Jesus is so much more than just following rules. Does God See the Problems I'm Facing?



The priests blew their trumpets again, and the soldiers shouted as loud as they could. The walls of Jericho fell flat. Then the soldiers rushed up the hill, went straight into the town, and captured it.

Joshua 6:20

You've probably already figured out that banging your head against a wall won't solve your problems. Thankfully, God has better ideas for how to deal with things that hold you back.

When the Israelites went to live in the land God promised them, they ran into a real wall. The town of Jericho was in the way. The town had a massive wall and was filled with evil people ready to fight for their land. How would they get past?

But God had a plan for them. He told the Israelite priests and army to march around the city carrying his sacred box, once a day for six days.

It wasn't too hard to march around the walls—well, except maybe being quiet the whole time. And patiently doing what God says when it doesn't seem to make sense isn't always easy. On the seventh day, God had the Israelites march around the city in silence seven more times. Finally, they blew their trumpets and shouted to God. Immediately, the wall fell down in a great crash. With a God like that on their side, the army easily conquered Jericho.

God sees the problems we face and has a plan to help us—sometimes all we need to do is trust him and follow his lead.

Does God Help the Good Guys in Battle?



*So the sun and the moon stopped and stood still
until Israel defeated its enemies.*

Joshua 10:13a

Things fall when you drop them. The earth spins so the sun comes up in the east and goes down in the west. These are laws God made. But God can suspend his own laws, and sometimes he does to help his people.

Joshua and the Israelite army learned about an enemy encampment with five kings. Joshua asked God what they should do, and God said to attack them. He told Joshua, "I've already given you this battle."

So Joshua and the Israelites marched all night, uphill, about 15 miles. Coming into battle tired doesn't seem like the best strategy! But when they arrived, God confused the enemy and they panicked. The Israelites immediately started to kill them.

The enemy troops ran away. And God killed more of them than Joshua's army did. He rained hailstones down on these enemy troops. Still, many were escaping. Joshua realized they were going to run out of daylight, and some might escape in the dark.

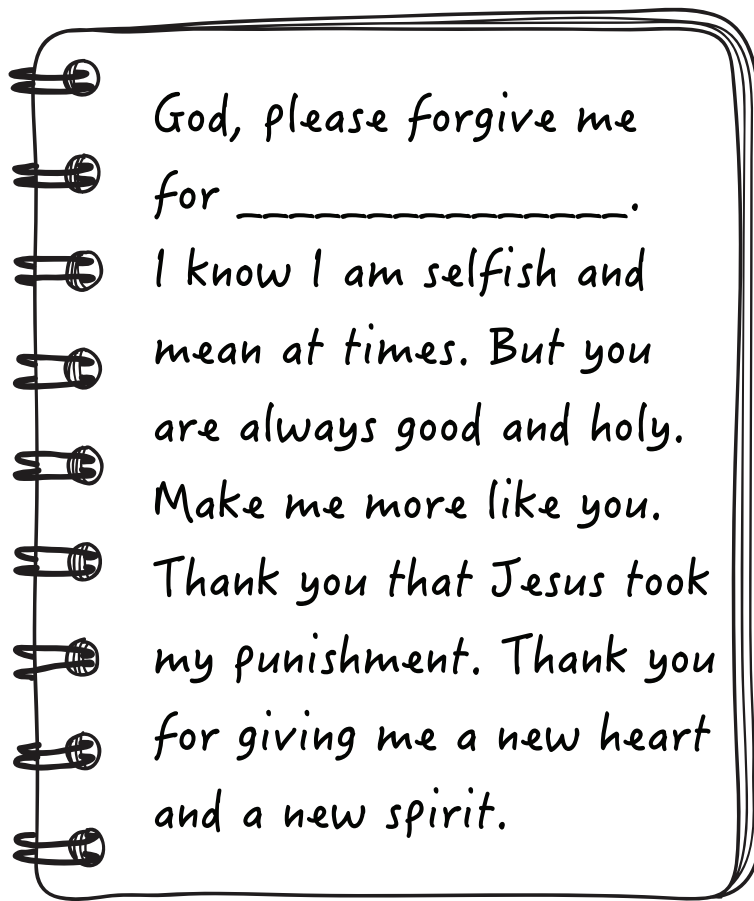
He asked God to make the day longer. And God did. He stopped the sun in its tracks to help his good guys win the war. God does help the good guys in battle, even in ways that seem impossible, because He is powerful and always ready to help those who trust in Him!

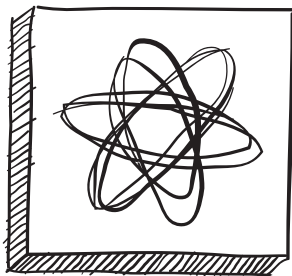

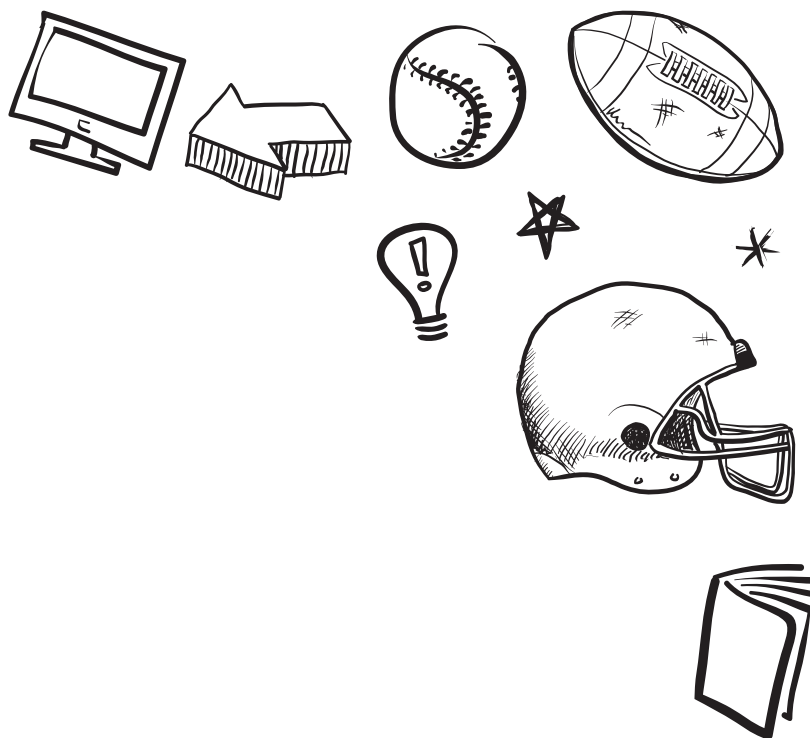

Mark 5:13

Some stories leave us with lots of questions. Here are the facts on this one:

Jesus and his disciples crossed Lake Galilee and landed near a small town. As they started to get out of the boat, a man came roaring at them.

He was naked. Super strong. He lived in the graveyard and ran around screaming and cutting himself with stones. No one could control him—he broke all the chains they used to hold him. A real-life Hulk.

But when he saw Jesus, he fell on his knees in front of him. Jesus talked to the demons living in the man. He told them to leave. They said there were a lot of them and they wanted to go into a nearby herd of pigs instead. When Jesus gave them permission, the man shrieked and the pigs stampeded into the lake and drowned.

Then the man was calm. He got some clothes on and sat down with Jesus. But here's the super crazy part: when the townspeople found out the good thing that had happened to their wild man, they begged Jesus to leave!

There are lots of things left hanging here, but we can know two things: Jesus controls demons who want to destroy us, and he cares even for people who are out of control. He has power over evil, and we want to stay on his side!

But it wasn't God who had left them. They left him to worship other gods. When they finally asked the real God for help, he sent his angel to Gideon.

God patiently told Gideon that he was to lead the Israelites to victory. Gideon asked a lot more questions. Then he brought food for the angel and placed it on a rock. When the angel touched the food with his stick, fire consumed it and the angel disappeared.

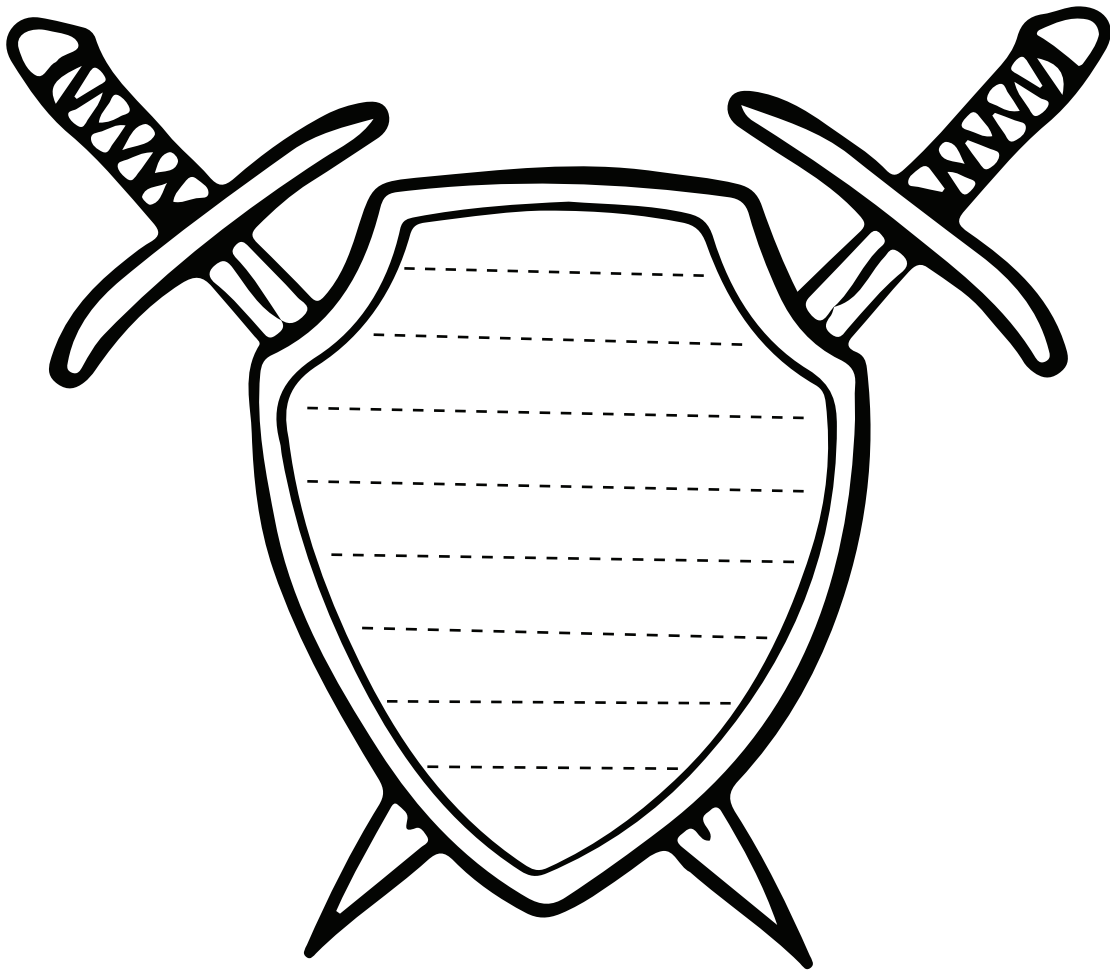
Gideon still wasn't sure about this warrior stuff, so he asked the Lord for some more signs. God made the ground dry and some fleece wet for Gideon. Then the next day he made the fleece dry and the ground wet.

Finally, Gideon took a small army up against a massive enemy, and God won the battle for him. God made Gideon into the mighty warrior the Israelites needed.

Then he shouted, "Let me die with the Philistines!" He pushed against the columns as hard as he could, and the temple collapsed with the Philistine rulers and everyone else still inside. Samson killed more Philistines when he died than he had killed during his entire life.

Judges 16:30

Weak, blind, in prison, all because of a woman. Sounds like a bad country song. But it was Samson's life.

Things had started well. An angel visited Samson's parents before he was born and said Samson would help save Israel from their enemies, the Philistines. But he needed to obey the angel's instructions. God gave him great strength, and Samson used it to make lots of trouble for those enemies.

But then ... the woman. One of the Philistine girls. He was in love, and she took advantage of that, pestering him until he finally gave in and told her why he was strong: He was dedicated to God, and if his hair was cut he would lose his strength.

He woke up in her arms with a bad haircut and no strength. His enemies clobbered him, gouged out his eyes, and threw him in prison.

He prayed to God for one more chance. And his hair started to regrow. Then one day the bad guys threw a big party for their god and used Samson for entertainment. He found the main support beams of the massive dining hall; he found his strength from God; and he brought the house down, collapsing the roof and killing thousands, including himself.

We should use the gifts God gives us to honor him and help others.
