The cows went straight up the road toward Beth-Shemesh, mooing as they went. The Philistine rulers followed them until they got close to Beth-Shemesh.

1 Samuel 6:12

The Israelites leaders screwed up. They disobeyed God's rules and thought they could make him do what they wanted. They sent the Israelite army out in battle against the Philistines without asking God first. They faced the consequences and lost the battle. So then they got the bright idea they would bring out the ark of the covenant—a golden box that symbolized God's presence and power.

But ... God isn't some lucky rabbit's foot for you to use. They lost again, and worse, the enemies captured the ark.

The Philistines put the ark by the statue of their god, Dagon. But that night the statue fell over in front of the ark. They set it up again. It fell over again and was busted. Then God gave the Philistines terrible tumors. Many died.



Mark 6:50–51

Jesus and his disciples were tired. They had tried to get away from a crowd by going to the wilderness, only to find a new group waiting there. Jesus helped them all day. When the disciples wanted to send them away, Jesus fed them instead.

When night approached, Jesus sent the disciples back across the lake in a boat while he went up on a mountain to pray.

'But we don't want to cause trouble. So go cast a line into the lake and pull out the first fish you hook. Open its mouth, and you will find a coin. Use it to pay your taxes and mine."

Matthew 17:27

A lot of times, things don't go like you expect when you are with Jesus. Just ask Peter. One day, a couple of temple officials confront Peter about the mandatory temple tax. "Or doesn't Jesus pay that?" they ask. Peter quickly says he does. He doesn't want any trouble.

So, Peter is probably wondering where they are going to get the money. He goes into the house, but before he can say anything, Jesus asks him if a king's sons have to pay taxes. Well, no, says Peter. That would be weird. The people pay the king's tax, not his family.

Jesus agrees, and then says, "But we don't want to cause trouble, so we will pay it anyway." Jesus is basically saying he is part of God the King's family, so technically they don't have to pay the temple tax.

Then Jesus tells Peter to go fishing. Peter thought he would take his net out on his family boat and sell the fish go get the money. But no. Jesus says, "Cast one hook on a line, catch one fish, and the exact coin we need will be in its mouth."

Do you suppose Jesus and Peter came away laughing at the weird way they paid their taxes? One of the many perks of being a child of God is getting to trust that your Father in Heaven knows what you need—and He can take care of you in the most unexpected and awesome ways!

After Jesus said this, he spit on the ground. He made some mud and smeared it on the man's eyes. Then he said, "Go wash off the mud in Siloam Pool." The man went and washed in Siloam, which means "One Who Is Sent." When he had washed off the mud, he could see.

John 9:6–7

You would think making a blind man be able to see would convince people that Jesus had God's power. But some wouldn't believe even what was in front of their own eyes.

Jesus and his disciples met a man who had always been blind. Since birth, he had never seen the light of day. Jesus told him, "I am the light of the world" and then he proved it.

Jesus spit in some dirt, made it into clay, and then spread it on the man's eyes. Then Jesus told him to go wash it off. When he did, he could see!

Later, when people asked the man how it happened, he said Jesus did it. That made the religious leaders angry. Jesus was a threat to their power, and now he had done a powerful miracle. They tried to call the man a liar, but here he was—blind before, and now looking at them. They kept arguing with him, but the man could see it more clearly than those who had always had their sight—Jesus healed him!

When people challenge your faith, you have an opportunity to just tell the truth about what Jesus has done for you, and you can trust God to give you courage.





### What Do I Do When Nobody Else Believes in God?



The LORD immediately sent fire, and it burned up the sacrifice, the wood, and the stones. It scorched the ground everywhere around the altar and dried up every drop of water in the ditch.

1 Kings 18:38

Israel was trying to have it both ways. They worshipped God—sometimes—but they were also worshipping an awful god named Baal. The queen had even had hundreds of God's prophets killed. So God sent the prophet Elijah to confront the prophets of Baal.

The odds were over 400 to 1. They agreed to meet on Mount Carmel, build altars to their gods, and see which one responded with fire. That was the one they would worship.

The followers of Baal built their altar, stacked up wood like a scout troop, sacrificed a bull, and put it on top. Then they prayed. But their storm god didn't respond. They chanted, danced, yelled. Nothing. They even cut themselves, hoping the sight of blood would wake Baal up. Elijah began to laugh at them: maybe Baal was on the toilet!

When they had worn themselves out, Elijah built his altar and placed wood and a bull on it. But then he had people pour water over it until everything was soaked and a moat of water surrounded it. Then Elijah prayed to the Lord Almighty.


And fire came down. It was so hot it burned everything—even the stones and the water! The people got the point: the Lord is God! So, when it feels like you are the only one who believes in God, stand firm, pray boldly, and trust that God will show up in His power.


True healing and joy starts with Jesus—trust him, worship him, and never forget to thank Him with all your heart.






When you're worn out, run to God and let Him give you the strength and love you need to keep going.

Tears turned into shouts and joy. "Unwrap him!" said Jesus with a grin.


Jesus holds the power over death, and we can trust his promise that those who trust in him will live, even if they die!





When they came to the Jordan River, Elijah hit the water with his cloak and it backed up so they could walk across on dry land. Then Elijah asked if there was anything he could do for Elisha before he was taken away. Elisha said that he wanted the spirit that helped Elijah so he could carry on Elijah's work. The prophet said that if Elisha saw him being taken to heaven, it would mean God would give him that spirit.

Suddenly, a fiery chariot pulled by horses of fire swooped down between them, and a whirlwind took Elijah up into heaven. Elisha saw Israel's calvary and chariots.

When he couldn't see anything more, he picked up Elijah's cloak, which had fallen down. He went back to the river, hit the water, and again walked over on dry land. God will give you what you need, including his Holy Spirit, when someone you look up to is gone.
