When Jesus died, there was an earthquake, and in the middle of the day, the sky turned dark like it was nighttime.




God, everything we can do is because you help us. Thank you for all the beautiful things you give.


Paul told the sailors that an angel from God had said they would all be safe. But his message was hard to believe.


