### **How Do We Know Christianity Is True?**



The angel said to the women, "Don't be afraid! I know you are looking for Jesus, who was nailed to a cross. He isn't here! God has raised him to life, just as Jesus said he would. Come, see the place where his body was lying."

Matthew 28:5-6

They killed him. Many people in Jesus's day refused to believe in his miracles, even when there was no other explanation. They did not want to admit he was God's Son, and they did not want to do what he said.

And so, they made up fake charges and sentenced him to death. They beat him, made fun of him, nailed his wrists and feet to a cross, and left him to die. Then they buried him, sealed the tomb with a rock, and posted soldiers to watch the grave. Done.... or so they thought.

But they weren't as in control as they imagined. When Jesus died, there was an earthquake, mysterious darkness, and the curtain in the Temple that kept people from seeing into its holiest area was ripped open.

On his third day in the grave, he suddenly wasn't. An earthquake shook the city again. The stone in front of the grave moved. An angel appeared, making hardened soldiers run in fear. Jesus's body was gone, but the wrappings were left in a flattened pile, as if the body had been vaporized.

Soon, the people who loved Jesus saw him alive. Hundreds more reported seeing him walking, talking, eating, and breathing, and finally rising into the sky.

We know Christianity is true because Jesus rose from the dead, just like He promised.

Because Jesus proved his power over death, we can know what he said was true.



### What Does It Mean That God Is *FOR* Me?



Then he prayed, "LORD, please help him to see." And the LORD let the servant see that the hill was covered with fiery horses and flaming chariots all around Elisha.

2 Kings 6:17

Sometimes, the truth is even more amazing than fiction. Take, for example, Elisha's story. Elisha's country, Israel, was at war with the people of Aram. Aram's king kept trying to secretly move his troops, but the Israelites were always a step ahead of him. He thought he had a spy, but one of his soldiers said, "No, it's the Israelite named Elisha. He is a prophet of God, and he knows what you say in your bedroom."

So the king of Aram sent his best troops after Elisha. When Elisha's servant saw them coming, he was terrified. "What are we going to do?" he asked.

But Elisha was completely calm! He said it was no big deal because his army was bigger. The servant looked around. He couldn't see anything.

Then Elisha prayed, and his servant suddenly could see horses and chariots everywhere—and they were made of fire!

Elisha prayed again, this time asking God to blind the enemy. Just like that, the whole army lost its sight. Elisha led them to the Israelite king and then asked God to open their eyes again. They were surrounded.

God told the Israelites to feed their captives and then send them home. Because of God's supernatural power and Israel's kindness, the invasions stopped for a good while. God being *FOR* you means that he is always on your side, protecting you with His power even when you can't see it.







Acts 2:4

Unless... God sends another miracle to you, like he did for Jesus's followers. After his death, they had seen him alive again, but they were keeping quiet and hiding in Jerusalem. They were afraid of the people who had killed Jesus. Besides, Jesus had told them to wait there.

While they were waiting together, they suddenly heard a sound like a loud wind inside the building. Then they saw what looked like tongues made of fire moving around the room and resting over everyone's heads. The Holy Spirit's power had come to them, and they weren't afraid anymore.

People from all over the city came to see what was going on. They were from many nations, but the followers of Jesus could suddenly speak all their languages. They all told the same message about Jesus. Peter (the former coward) spoke boldly to the large crowd. He said Jesus had been killed but rose again. He pleaded with them to follow Jesus. Three thousand people believed that day!



### Do I Have to Stand for God?



"But I see four men walking around in the fire," the king replied. "None of them is tied up or harmed, and the fourth one looks like a god." Daniel 3:25

Imagine that you and a couple of buddies are taken as captives to another country. Things aren't terrible at first. But then the king gets a bright idea: he's going to make a god. (How crazy is that? Make a god!) He builds a 90-foot-tall gold statue and gathers a large group of musicians to form a band. He tells everyone to bow in worship of this idol whenever the music plays.

So, what's your move? Would you bow? In ancient times, three Jewish guys—Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego—were forced to answer this question. They chose to not bow down.

A bunch of tattletales ran to the king and told him the news. He gave them another chance, but they refused. These young men believed that God could save them, but told the evil king, "Even if he doesn't, we still won't worship your gods and the gold statue you have set up" (Daniel 3:18).

The king got so angry, he fired up a massive furnace, tied up the three friends, and ordered his men to throw them into the flames. But when the king looked into the fire, he saw four guys walking around—and the fourth one looked like the Son of God (spoiler alert: it was).

The king was stunned. He called them out of the fire and told everyone to worship their God. We have to stand for God, even when it's hard, because He is truthworthy.

Miracles

Sooner or later, you will have to show people that you believe in God. He honors that.





But that night an angel from the Lord opened the doors of the jail and led the apostles out. Acts 5:19

Some people are so controlling. Take, for instance, when the apostles were in the streets of Jerusalem, telling everyone about Jesus. The religious leaders got mad at them. Really? For healing people and telling them to do good? Those officials didn't only want to control religion—they wanted power over everyone's lives. Plus, they didn't like being blamed for Jesus's death. So they locked up his disciples in jail.

But God let them out. Yup, an angel came in the night and released them. The next morning, when the officials looked for them, they found the doors locked and guards in place, but no one inside.

Where were the prisoners? Back out preaching. So the leaders hauled them into court again, which gave Peter a chance to preach to them. They still didn't like it. The leaders were going to kill them, but one of them said, "Leave them alone. If what they are planning is something of their own doing, it will fail" (Acts 5:38b). Little did he know: God had started a worldwide mission.


So the religious officials decided to beat up the disciples and make them promise to not preach about Jesus. The disciples said they couldn't stop doing what God told them to do. And they didn't. To them, it was better to risk being hurt because of Jesus than being safe without him. Going with the flow might be easier, but following Jesus is always worth it.







So Philip began at this place in the Scriptures and explained the good news about Jesus.

Acts 8:35

Philip was sold out for Jesus. He was willing to go anywhere, do anything for him. And God used him in big ways.

First, Philip went to Samaria to preach. Samaritans and Jews didn't get along really well, but Philip was willing to cross that divide. Many people became followers of Jesus, and Philip was even able to heal people from diseases and demons.

Then one day, God told Philip to go to a road in the desert. There he found an Ethiopian man (who was a government official) in a fancy chariot, reading a prophecy about Jesus from the book of Isaiah. When Philip asked the man about it, he said he didn't understand what he was reading. Then he invited Philip to ride with him and teach him.

The Ethiopian decided right there to follow Jesus, too, and when they came to water, he wanted to be baptized. Philip agreed, and this man from Africa was welcomed into God's family.

Then suddenly, Philip disappeared! God picked him up and took him to another town that needed to hear the good news. The Ethiopian praised God, went home, and told people in his country about God's Son. Being baptized means showing the world that you've decided to follow Jesus—and that you're part of God's forever family.

Baptism shows everyone that a person has accepted God's forgiveness and will live for Jesus.



You praised idols made of silver, gold, bronze, iron, wood, and stone, even though they cannot see or hear or think. You refused to worship the God who gives you breath and controls everything you do.

Daniel 5:23

Remember arrogant King Nebuchadnezzar? Well, his son, Bekshazzar, didn't learn the lesson from seeing his dad go crazy and live outdoors with wild animals. When Belshazzar became king, he also became full of himself.

He threw a big party for a thousand of his friends and ordered his servants to bring the gold and silver goblets that came from the temple in Israel. While they were drinking from those cups that were dedicated to God, they were worshiping gods made of gold, silver, bronze, iron, wood, and stone.

Suddenly, a hand appeared and wrote a message on the wall while the king watched. That got his attention. He was scared like a little kid. None of his wise men knew what the words meant. His mother reminded him that someone was living in the kingdom who could explain the writing: Daniel.

So Daniel came and reminded Belshazzar how God punished his father for being arrogant and refusing to worship him. Then he said that because Belshazzar was proud and worshiping false gods—and even had used God's holy cups—he would lose his kingdom.

That very night, Belshazzar was killed, and a new ruler named Darius the Mede replaced him. The writing on the wall said it all. God is the true King over all kings and nations, and He has the final say.







Saul was so sure he was doing the right things. God had to literally knock some sense into him. Saul believed Christians were leading people away from God, so he was going to stop it. He watched while a man named Stephen was killed for preaching about Jesus. Then he started to hunt down more Christ-followers.

He headed to a city named Damascus, but on the road, a light flashed around him and knocked him to the ground. Then a voice asked him, "Why are you persecuting me?" His friends traveling with him heard it too, but couldn't see anybody. Saul asked, "Who are you?"

Imagine how shocked he was to hear "I am Jesus." Jesus—the One he thought was dead; the One all these people were worshiping. Jesus told Saul to go into the city and wait for someone to visit him. Saul got up, but he was blinded. His friends had to lead him.

Then God told Ananias to go pray for Saul. But Ananias didn't want to. This was the guy who was jailing Christians. God said again, "Go! Saul will preach to many."

Ananias obeyed. He put his hands on Saul and prayed for him. The Holy Spirit filled Saul, and he was suddenly able to see again. If God forgave Saul, who hurt God's people, he can forgive anything we've done when we turn to him with repentent hearts.

### Does It Really Pay to Be Good in the End?



The king was relieved to hear Daniel's voice, and he gave orders for him to be taken out of the pit. Daniel's faith in his God had kept him from being harmed.

Daniel 6:23

Some people, like King Darius and his leaders, don't learn from history. They could have saved themselves a lot of trouble. But no, they wanted to play god.

King Darius liked Daniel. He wanted to put him in charge of everything. Good move. But that made some people jealous. Daniel's new enemies tried to find a way to get rid of him, but Daniel was "honest and faithful and did everything he was supposed to do" (Daniel 6:4b). But the bad guys knew Daniel was loyal to God and his laws above everything else. So, they came up with the bright idea to write a law that commanded everyone to worship the king alone. This plan made King Darius puff up like a peacock, and he signed it.

When Daniel heard about it, he went home and prayed. To the real God. In front of an open window. Three times a day. Those jealous opponents had him right where they wanted him. The king was horrified, realizing he'd been tricked, but there was no way out. Just before throwing Daniel into the lion's den, King Darius said to him, "You have been faithful to your God, and I pray that he will rescue you" (Daniel 6:16b).

First thing in the morning, Darius was back at the den, calling for Daniel, wondering if his God was more powerful than lions. Daniel let him know that the true God had rescued him by sending an angel to shut the lions' mouths. Then the king ordered that Daniel's enemies be thrown into the den. This time, the lions were free to eat! God sees everything, stands by those who stay faithful, and always has the last word!





But Paul's story is different. When the ship was about to sink, the crew started listening to the guy who told them not to go in the first place. This Paul was a follower of Jesus—and a Roman prisoner—on his way to talk to Caesar (the ruler of the empire).

They had just started sailing when the wind suddenly started blowing hard. The waves beat them like a boxer and the clouds came in so thick they couldn't tell if it was night or day. For two weeks, they were helplessly pushed around. They lost all track of where they were.

Yet during it all, this passenger named Paul stayed calm. And now he was saying God sent an angel who promised him that even though the ship would be destroyed, they were all going to survive. They weren't sure how that was possible, but his courage was contagious.



### Will People Get What They Deserve?



The LORD commanded the fish to vomit up Jonah on the shore. And it did.

Jonah 2:10

"I would rather die." This line was basically what the prophet Jonah said when God told him to go preach in the town of Nineveh. He hated the Ninevites and wanted to see God punish (not forgive!) them.

So, Jonah tried to run away . . . from God. (It's not too smart to go against God.) He jumped on a boat going in the opposite direction and went to sleep, trying to forget the whole thing.

But you can't run away from God or his love. He sent a storm to play with the boat for a while until the sailors were sure they were going to die. They flipped a coin to figure out who caused this problem, and it revealed Jonah! He had to admit he was running away from the God who made the sea. Then he said they should throw him overboard.

The crew tossed Jonah into the raging water, and it fixed their problem immediately. The sea went flat. But Jonah's problem got even worse. He sank into the depths of the sea. Then God sent a big fish to swallow him whole.


After three days sloshing around in the stomach of the beast, Jonah finally turned back to God, thanking him and promising to go to Nineveh. The Bible says that after Jonah's change of heart, "The LORD commanded the fish to vomit up Jonah on the shore. And it did" (Jonah 2:10). People might not get what they deserve right away—but God always sees the whole story, and He gives justice and mercy at just the right time.
