James 4:13-15

¹³ You should know better than to say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to the city. We will do business there for a year and make a lot of money!" ¹⁴ What do you know about tomorrow? How can you be so sure about your life? It is nothing more than mist that appears for only a little while before it disappears. ¹⁵ You should say, "If the Lord lets us live, we will do these things."

If the Lord Lets Us

As a military family, you know better than most how quickly plans can change—deployments, moves, sudden orders.

James reminds us that even the best plans are never fully in our control.

Maybe some things didn't go as you expected this year.

Maybe there were blessings, and maybe there were battles.

But through it all, God never lost sight of your family.

As we step into a new year, James's words in this passage aren't meant to discourage planning—for our families, for

spiritual growth, for service—but to realign our hearts with humble dependence on God, who sees what we can't.

"If the Lord lets us..."

Adding this simple phrase to our plans is not because we're unsure of God's goodness—but because we trust that his will is better than ours.

We say, "If the Lord lets us," because the truth is: he has brought us through before, and he will again.

So, take some time to pray as a family, asking the Lord to give you open hands and deep trust that
